### Instrumental


E.g. a means to effectiveness or expansion of disciplinary knowledge


### Statutory

## Systemic principles for equitable collaboration AND research



- Put poverty first define starting conditions/assumptions
- 2. Critically engage with context(s) acknowledge path-dependency and particularities
- 3. Respect diversity of knowledge and skills; 5. redress evidence hierarchies; 6. commit to transparency acknowledge difference and inter-dependencies
- 4. Adapt/respond; 7.invest in relationships; 8.keep learning— embrace emergence

# UK-based academics and funders should consider...



- Starting conditions and assumptions: framing pathways to research impact in relation to development impact
- Understanding the context and the place of 'partners' within that context – how do they engage with regional/national/global knowledge systems?
- Diversity and representation in agenda-setting and peerreview as well as research, communication and use
- Developing long-term, emergent collaborations with sufficient time for context analysis, relationship-building, adaptation and learning
