



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### WHAT CAN BE HELPFUL



- Multi-staged research funding allocation of reasonable resources to develop proposal including community consultations and strengthening partnership
- Result framework should emphasise enough on N-S partnership and capacity building along impact pathways – it should be evaluated along with other results
- Research design should include engagement with local stakeholders - not an afterthought or postfacto
- A critical balance in relationship between individual and institution institutionalising relationship
